SCHOLARSHIPS

1. <u>Purpose</u>: To provide guidelines for administering a consistent and successful division scholarship program.

2. <u>Authority</u>: This rule was approved by the Division 3 membership attending its annual conference held April 26-27, 2019. It will be reviewed annual and reissued as applicable.

3. **Procedures**:

A. Division 3 will offer up to two \$500.00 scholarships per year, based on available funds. The scholarship winners to be named at its annual conference.

B. A Parade of Checks fundraiser will be conducted at the annual division conference to fund this program. Any excess monies will be deposited into the general fund and used to support other objectives or programs.

C. Exhibit 1 contains the application and checklist to be used in the submission process. The application contains eligibility requirements and submission deadlines.

D. The Scholarship Chair will:

1. Forward an updated application/checklist to the division president every year for dissemination to chapter presidents. This will be performed in sufficient time to permit chapter presidents to advertise the program in their areas of operation to help gain maximum participation.

2. Assemble a panel to review and recommend the winners.

3. Provide a report summary to the division president and annual conference attendees with total participation and winners. A sample report is contained in Exhibit 2.

4. Secure payment from the Treasurer and insure their mailing to the winners.
