In April, we attended the AFSA Division 3 Conference in Wichita, KS. Eight individuals represented the Chapter. AFSA and Division business were topics of discussion. Division President Zalesky announced the two proposed By-Law changes to be presented to the delegates at the AFSA International PAC in August. The first proposed change is to make the AFSA International Family Matters Trustee a permanent and voting member of the AFSA International Council. The second one is a resurrection of the By-Law change that was presented two years ago to allow all branches of service to become active members of AFSA with the right to vote and hold office. At that time, the AFSA name was to be changed to read, if passed, to "Armed Forces Services Association". It was defeated. The only change to this proposal is to let the AFSA name remain as it presently is, "Air Force Sergeants Association". We are very honored to announce we brought home Division awards for Barbara Veach as Family Member of the Year, Hershell Spurlock as VAVS Member of the Year, the Chapter Volunteer Service Award and Mark Clark, Division Exemplary Award and Division Lifetime Trustee Award. Election of Officers was held and one new Trustee was selected, Bobby Kazmir. A great time was had by all.

In the past month, we have lost two dear Family Members from our Chapter. We send out our condolences and prayers to these families. Helen O'Roark, a Life Member who served this Chapter as its Luncheon Chairperson for many years and was active in our organization, passed away on May 13th. Another long-standing Family Member we lost on May 15th was Addy Davidson. She was one of our Auxiliary Presidents, was selected as the first Division Coordinator and continued to faithfully serve this Membership for many, many years in numerous areas. They will be sadly missed.

A Big Vote of Thanks goes to those individuals that assisted in putting together the crafts and baked goods for our most recent fundraiser. We took part in the American Legion Auxiliary Craft Show on May 19<sup>th</sup>. ## **CHAPTER HISTORY**

#### "Reflections"

#### AFSA Heart of America Chapter 804 "Ring of Honor"

Back in the January Newsletter, the Chapter History article listed 16 members chosen as the initial members in our "Chapter Ring of Honor". In this article we will begin to highlight some of those members through the 56 years of our Chapter's existence. We will begin with two members who, in 1962, were part of the initial planning and organizing committee and became Charter Members of Chapter 804, then known as 504. **Raymon Doss** and **Claude Jewell** were both very instrumental in recruiting a total of 168 members to start the chapter.

**Raymon G. Doss:** Originally from Syracuse, NY, Ray served in the Air Force from 1945 - June 1966. While stationed at Clark AB in the Philippines in 1961, Ray became very interested in the then brand-new Air Force Enlisted Organization called AFSA. He became one of its Original 1,000 Charter members at #824. Ray came to Richards-Gebaur AFB in January of 1962 and began spreading the word of the new Organization which led to planning meetings, recruiting interested members and the application process to start a chapter at R-G. He served in various positions in the Chapter, including Chapter President. Ray now resides in Grand Prairie, TX. He is a Life Member of AFSA and remains in touch with our Chapter through our Newsletter. I spoke with him recently and he is so very proud of our Chapter's continued success through the past 56 years.

<u>Claude E. Jewell, Jr.</u>: Originally from Campbell & Boonville, MO, Claude enlisted in the U.S. Navy at the age of 16 and served from 1944-1946. He then moved to the Air Force and served until 1973. Claude was stationed at R-G three different times and is a walking encyclopedia of history of the base and our AFSA Chapter. His first time at the base was in the spring of 1954 when personnel and equipment was moved from Fairfax Field in Kansas City, KS, to the base then known as Grandview AFB. A few years ago, he shared some of his memories with me on those early construction years of the base. He recalled that the first barracks built that year was for the WAFs (Women of the Air Force); however, there were no WAFs to occupy the building. Very strange.

He also shared a picture taken in 1962 of the seven members that comprised the AFSA Planning Committee. In the picture to the right, Claude is seated at the far left and Ray Doss is standing second from the left.



The efforts in planning, organizing and recruiting of these two original Charter Members resulted in the Original Charter titled *Kansas City Chapter*, *No. 504* dated July 17<sup>th</sup>, 1962, and signed by AFSA President Benny McGehee and Executive Secretary Lee Thompson, two of the Original Founders of AFSA.

## **RECIPE CORNER**

#### **Cherry Cheesecake Ice Cream**

3 cups cold heavy cream
1 14-oz can sweetened condensed milk
1 tsp vanilla extract
1 cup hand-crushed graham crackers
(about 4 whole crackers
1 cup cherry pie filling

- Using an electric mixer, beat the cream in a large bowl on medium-high speed until stiff peaks form, 2 to 3 minutes.
- Fold in the sweetened condensed milk and vanilla until fully incorporated, then fold in the graham cracker crumbs.
- Transfer half the mixture to a large 10 x 5-inch loaf pan. Dollop 1/2 cup pie filling over the top, then swirl with a butter knife. Add remaining cream mixture, then swirl in remaining 1/2 cup pie filling.
- Freeze until firm, at least 8 hours, covering lightly with plastic wrap after 4 hours. Serve with additional crushed graham crackers, if desired.
